God takes it seriously when He gives instructions. 1 Kings chapter 13 gives an account of God’s prophet, on God’s mission, who allowed another man to persuade him to eat a meal in a place where God had forbidden him to eat. The other man falsely claimed to also have a word from God. This simple act of disobedience cost the prophet his life.

You and I would be wise to follow God’s instruction, regardless of how plausible some contrary advice might be. How can we **know** what God’s instructions are? A steady diet of Bible study and prayer is a great start.
